INSURANCE

The insurance cover for this event will be **BASIC** (limit of liability £10 Million) (as selected by the Organiser and indicated on the Permit Application for this event). **Medical Malpractice Insurance** (limit of liability £5 Million) is included in either case. There is **NO Personal Accident Insurance for Competitors**. Competitors are therefore strongly recommended to purchase such Cover which is available through the Locktons website (www.locktonmotorsport.com) or the ACU website (www.acu.org.uk).

Supplementary Regulations

1. Jurisdiction: A Hare and Hound event for solo motorcycles held under the Hare & Hounds Standing Regulations of the National Sporting Code, Auto Cycle Union, these supplementary regulations and any Final instructions that may be issued for the meeting. Full details are available from the ACU handbook.
2. Eligibility: Open solo (Enduro, Trail and Moto-X) motorcycles. Working lights are not required. **ACU 2012 licence required**, ACU day licence available £10.00.
3. Venue: Clouds Hill Bovington, Dorset. Signed from the Bere Regis to Wool road and the B3390
4. Course: Approximately 7 miles consisting of mixed Forest terrain and open Forest tracks.
5. Classes: Championship, Expert, Clubman A, Clubman B, Over 40 Clubman, Sportsman
6. Machine Examination : 0900 -1015 a.m.
Sound testing @ 94 Decibels. All Loud bikes will be excluded.
Riders must produce (clean) Bike, Helmet and Fire extinguisher (No extinguisher no refueling).
Numbers: must be displayed front and sides as per ACU handbook
7. **TYRES: REAR TRIALS**, front no restriction. (19 inch rear may use speedway tyre).
8. Entries: Close when full and will be accepted strictly in order of receipt. Entries will only be accepted on an official entry form sent to the sec of the meeting together with entry fee (payment by cheque or postal order only) and 3 Stamp addressed envelopes.
All payments to **Dorset Police MCC**.
9. Non starters: Anyone who enters this event must give at least 7 days notice in writing of non attendance to be **considered** for a refund. An admin charge of £10:00 will be deducted from refunds.
10. Event Timing: Portsmouth MCRC will be timing the event. All riders will be loaned a transponder at signing on. All transponders will be returned immediately the race finishes or else

ENTRY DECLARATION:

- I / we the undersigned apply to enter the event described and in consideration thereof: -
- I / we hereby declare that I / we have had the opportunity to read, and that I / we understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU Standing Regulations, such Supplementary Regulations as have or may be issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them.
